INSTAGRAM is a photo based social network with over 700 million users worldwide. It is a popular alternative to Facebook for children and young people.

Instagram allows you to share pictures with "Followers" who can like or comment on your photos. There is also a direct messaging feature which can be accessed by non-Followers and the ability to share pictures and videos for a short length of time—similar to Snapchat.

Although Instagram does not ask

for date of birth when setting up a profile, users are required to be over the age of 13.

Some of Instagram's security features include giving your control over who can see your posted photos—they can be public so everyone can see or you can set it to private so only followers can see. There is also the ability to hide inappropriate and offensive comments.
