## e-safety—Your Guide to What's Out There



**Musical.ly** is an online social network for phones and tablets, which let users share 15 second videos where a user can lip sync, dance or create a short film which can then be shared with their followers or others on the site, depending on settings. Videos can be given Hearts, which are similar to Likes on Facebook.

Musical.ly also comes with a direct messaging service, allowing users to communicate privately with

their 'followers'.

Users need to be over 13 to create an account, although the T&Cs state that you confirm you are over 18. It allows users to report under aged users which enables them to delete the accounts of under 13s.
