## STUDENT EXCHANGE

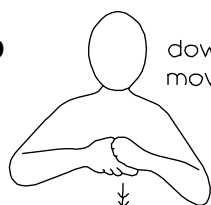


As part of their OCR Life Skills accreditation and extending our cross Federation working, Tyler and Chloe will be swapping places every Wednesday until Christmas.
